FINANCIAL CHALLENGES FACING NAZARENE PASTORS

- High levels of student debt from ministerial preparation
- 2. Excessive consumer debt and insufficient savings
- 3. Lack of retirement readiness
- Communication barriers between clergy & spouse and clergy & lay leaders regarding financial issues
- 5. Need for effective strategies to teach biblical financial management in the local church
- 6. Difficulty accessing financial management tools
- 7. Insufficient training and learning opportunities for the effective use of financial management tools



FINANCIAL LITERACY, MANAGEMENT, AND WELL-BEING

COMPASS Journey

A year-long process of assistance, education, and supportive accountability.

40 Lifelong Learning hours tailored to each individual minister.

Local church "COMPASS team" (pastor and 2 lay leaders) engage in transparent and safe conversations regarding the financial needs and challenges of the pastor.

COMPASS Quest

Two free online courses to improve financial health designed for pastor and churches.

Personal Finances Course: Six 90-minute monthly sessions for pastor and spouse on their own schedule. Includes online videos, links to best practices, books, and discussion.

Church Generosity Course: Six 20-45 minute sessions for pastor and lay leaders (3 or more) to do together. Video lessons teach and guide discussion on living generously, giving joyfully, and growing generous givers.

COMPASS Academy

An online, organized collection of resources for excellent biblical financial management and stewardship.

Resources include downloadable materials, webinars, training videos, books, and links to helpful resources.

COMPASS True North Retreat

An intensive weekend retreat for the pastor and spouse to address their personal finances.

Professional coaching and training to develop a livable budget and workable debt reduction plan.

District superintendent recommendation required.

Ministerial Excellence Fund

This fund provides matching grants to pastors and full-time associates who complete the COMPASS Journey (up to \$5,000) or the COMPASS Quest Personal Finances Course (up to \$1,000).

This grant is to assist pastors with additional contributions to their Nazarene 403(b)
Retirement Savings Plan accounts OR to enable pastors to pay down debilitating educational debt and other forms of personal debt.



Reducing the financial strain experienced by a significant number of ministers will empower them to lead effectively as they model and teach biblical financial stewardship.
